Luminant Scholar Program is a scholarship program designed to educate students about the natural resources we use each day. Through an essay contest in the fall, students in select Texas school districts increased their awareness of environmental protection. Luminant awards each district winner a \$1,000 United States Savings Bond, and three schools representing the top essays receive a \$5,000 Luminant grant.
