In accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 257.102(h), Dynergy Midwest Generation, LLC (Dynergy) is providing notification that the closure of Hennepin Old West Polishing Pond was completed on November 17, 2020.

IPRG has attached the certification from a qualified professional engineer verifying that that the CCR from the Hennepin Old West Polishing Pond has been removed in accordance with the written closure plan and 40 C.F.R. § 257.102. Any remaining groundwater monitoring concentrations that exceed the groundwater protection standard established pursuant to § 257.95(h) for constituents listed in appendix IV to this part are being addressed pursuant to 40 C.F.R. § 257.96 and 40 C.F.R. § 257.97 as stated in the Corrective Measures Assessment for the Old West Ash Pond and Old West Polishing Pond multi-unit dated September 5, 2019.


