Re: Duck Creek Power Plant – Update to Closure Plan for Bottom Ash Basin and GMF Pond

Illinois Power Resources Generating, LLC (IPRG) is providing an update to the closure plans associated with the Duck Creek Power Plant located near Canton, Illinois. *See* 40 C.F.R. § 257.102(b)(3)(i).

In April 2021 new Illinois state rules governing the management of CCR in Illinois became effective. In accordance with those new rules, we have submitted various documents to the Illinois EPA regarding the closure of the Bottom Ash Basin and GMF Pond. On January 31, 2022, we submitted construction permit applications to Illinois EPA, which are required under the Illinois CCR program, along with new closure plans detailing the proposed closure approach for the Bottom Ash Basin and GMF Pond.

Accordingly, we are updating our closure plans under 40 C.F.R. § 257.102 to incorporate the proposals submitted to Illinois EPA, which will involve removal of the liner components at the Bottom Ash Basin and consolidation of ash for purposes of closure in place at the GMF Pond. IPRG's submission to Illinois EPA of the new proposed closure plan contains relevant information for purposes of the federal CCR program and reflects the manner in which the Bottom Ash Basin and GMF Pond will be closed if approved by Illinois EPA. The construction permit applications submitted to Illinois EPA, which includes the proposed new closure plans, will be posted to Luminant's public CCR website, along with this letter.
