

Duck Creek Public Meeting, December 7, 2021

In accordance with 845.240(d) Illinois Power Resource Generating, LLC is providing documentation recording the public meeting.

On Sunday, November 7, 2021, Illinois Power Resource Generating, LLC made available to the public its plans to close and provide any necessary corrective action for the GMF Pond and Bottom Ash Basin (BAB) CCR surface impoundments located at Duck Creek Power Plant. On Tuesday, December 7, 2021, Illinois Power Resource Generating, LLC held in-person and virtual public meetings at 3:00 pm and 5:30pm to present its decision-making process, a comparison of projected groundwater impacts for the alternatives presented, and an objective comparison of the pros and cons of each alternative presented. During the question-and-answer portion of the meeting, the public asked questions relating to the closure and the company provided answers.

As required by Section 845.240(g), Illinois Power Resource Generating, LLC distributed to those public meeting attendees who requested a copy a general summary of the issues raised by the public. A response to those issues raised by the public and a summary of any revisions, changes and considerations made to the closure plans on December 21, 2021.

In accordance with 845.240(f)(4), a list of people who requested to be added to the IEPA Listserv were included in the construction permit application.
