

## **Vermilion Public Meeting, December 9, 2021**

In accordance with 845.240(d) Dynegey Midwest Generation, LLC is providing documentation recording the public meeting.

On Sunday, November 9, 2021, Dynegey Midwest Generation, LLC made available to the public its plans to close the Old East Ash Pond/North Ash Pond and New East Ash Pond CCR surface impoundments located at Vermilion Power Plant. On Thursday, December 9, 2021, Dynegey Midwest Generation, LLC held in-person and virtual public meetings at 3:00 pm and 5:30pm to present its decision-making process, a comparison of projected groundwater impacts for the alternatives presented, and an objective comparison of the pros and cons of each alternative presented. During the question-and-answer portion of the meeting, the public asked questions relating to the closure and the company provided answers.

As required by Section 845.240(g), Dynegey Midwest Generation, LLC distributed to those public meeting attendees who requested a copy a general summary of the issues raised by the public. A response to those issues raised by the public and a summary of any revisions, changes and considerations made to the closure plans on December 22, 2021.

In accordance with 845.240(f)(4), a list of people who requested to be added to the IEPA Listserv were included in the construction permit application.
